# Bulletin no 1

Call for papers and invitation to the Conference and Symposium





HYDROFORUM 2022 is already the 11th edition of the Polish Hydropower Conference series, organised annually by the Polish Hydropower Association (TEW), the Polish Association for Small Hydropower Development (TRMEW) and the Institute of Fluid-Flow Machinery of the Polish Academy of Sciences (IMP PAN) with the scope covering the problems of hydraulic machinery and equipment. especially those used in the hydropower industry. The current name, as adopted in 2019, emphasises the direct link to a renowned conference series organised in the period between 1973 and 2005 by the IMP PAN with the scope covering the problems of hydraulic machinery and equipment, especially rotodynamic machines and those used in the hydropower industry. In their current formula the HY-DROFORUM events represent a platform for discussing the challenges encountered by the hydropower sector in Poland and Europe in view of changes in its widely conceived surroundings. On the other hand the conferences serve exchange of opinions and information on the prospects and observed trends in sector development, experience on erection and operation of hydropower installations, new solutions to technical problems and the results of R&D efforts.

Despite their naming, the Polish Hydropower Conferences are international meetings. The debate is carried out in Polish and English, with simultaneous interpretation. The central item of the agenda is the HYDROFORUM Panel Debate, generally oriented on the sector problems in Poland and within the region. Representatives of central offices, widely conceived hydropower sector and research centres as well as independent experts are invited to the panel. The audience is always invited to active discussion as well. In 2018 the tradition of linking the conference with study visits at hydropower installations was restored. At the time this document is being written, a study visit at the Debe Hydro Power Plant is under preparation.

This year conference will incorporate the Life NEXUS Project Symposium. The essential goal of the project is promotion of recovery of energy lost in hydraulic installations – mainly in water networks and wastewater treatment plants. The Conference and the Symposium have been planned for 26-27 October this year. The event will be preceded by the TEW National Assembly on October 25th. while the possible study visit to Debe HPP is planned for October 28th.

The conference package will comprise the annual subscription of Energetyka Wodna quarterly, access to the electronic version of presentations and printed proceedings with extended abstracts of conference contributions. The authors of selected contributions will be invited to prepare post-conference papers to be published in the *Energetyka Wodna* quarterly. In case of potential authors' willingness and sufficient number of Scientific Committee recommendations (at least 6) a post-conference issue of the *Transactions of IFFM* will be also published.

## Conference venue and logistics


